



**Ministry of Corporate Affairs
Amended Section 67 of LLP Act to
include applicability of Section 460 of
Companies Act, 2013 to Limited
Liability Partnerships as well.**

Vide notification No. 17/61/2016-CL-V dated 30.01.2020, the central government directs that provisions of **section 460 of the Companies Act, 2013 (Condonation of Delay by Central Government in certain cases)** shall apply to a limited liability partnerships also from the date of publication of this notification (30.01.2020) in the official Gazette.

**What is section 460 (Condonation of
delay in Certain Cases) of Companies
Act, 2013?**

Under section 460 of the Companies Act

1. where any application required to be made to the Central Government

under any provision of this Act in respect of any matter is not made within the time specified therein, that Government may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, condone the delay; and

2. Where any document required to be filed with the Registrar under any provision of this Act is not filed within the time specified therein, the Central Government may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, condone the delay.
